

Leader 1:

People:

We give thanks for Jesus, who by his life, death, and resurrection, opened the dark places where treasure is found.

Leader 2:

We give thanks for the Holy Spirit, who gives us joy even in the midst of pain and sadness.

All:

We are grateful for your Church, the body of Christ, called to incarnate your justice and peace.

BLESSING THE ELEMENTS

Leader 1:

Christ invites everyone to eat the bread of life, to drink the cup of the new covenant.

Leader 2:

Jesus said, I am the bread of life.

You who come to me shall never hunger,

You who believe in me shall never thirst.

Leader 1:

On the night he gave himself up, Jesus took bread, and after giving thanks to God, broke it and said, This is my body, broken for the healing of the world. Whenever you eat it, do so remembering me.

Leader 2:

After supper, Jesus took the cup and said, This is the cup of the new covenant, poured out for you and for all. Whenever you drink it, do so remembering me.

All:

O Holy One, send down your Spirit that these gifts of bread and cup

may be for us the body and blood of Christ. Unite us with Christ forever and bring us with the whole creation to your eternal realm.
