

served, and for his presence with us as the living Christ. Leader 2: We thank you for your Holy Spirit setting us free to bear our lowliness. We thank you for your Holy Church, People: a channel of your healing grace in our broken world. BLESSING THE ELEMENTS Leader 1: Christ invites everyone to eat the bread of life, to drink the cup of the new covenant. Leader 2: Jesus said, I am the bread of life. You who come to me shall never hunger. You who believe in me shall never thirst. Leader 1: On the night he gave himself up, Jesus took bread, and after giving thanks to God, broke it and said, This is my body, broken for the healing of the world. Whenever you eat it, do so remembering me. Leader 2: After supper, Jesus took the cup and said, This is the cup of the new covenant, poured out for you and for all. Whenever you drink it, do so remembering me. All: O Holy One, send down your Spirit that these gifts of bread and cup may be for us the body and blood of Christ.
