Whenever you eat it, do so remembering me. Leader 2: After supper, Jesus took the cup and said, This is the cup of the new covenant, poured out for you and for all. Whenever you drink it, do so remembering me. A11: O Holy One, send down your Spirit that these gifts of grain and grape, and work of human hands may be for us the body and blood of Christ.
