
# 2024 Recommitment Liturgy: Be Opened

Leader 1: On the night he gave himself up, Jesus took bread, and after giving thanks to God, broke it and said,

This is my body, broken for the healing of the world. Whenever you eat it, do so remembering me.

Leader 2: After supper, Jesus took the cup and said, This is the cup of the new covenant, poured out for you and for all. Whenever you drink it, do so remembering me.

All: Holy One, send down your Spirit that these gifts of grain and grape, and work of human hands may be for us the body and blood of Christ. Unite us with Christ forever and bring us with the whole creation to your eternal realm.

Leader 1: The body of Christ, broken for all of us. Feed on Christ in your hearts with thanksgiving.

Leader 2: The cup of the new covenant, poured out for the healing of the world. Drink deeply of it.
