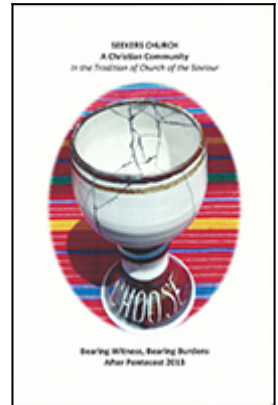


A Sermon by Marian Barton Peele
