

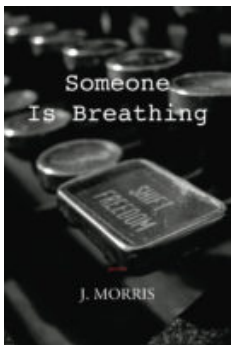
Books by John Morris

John shares:

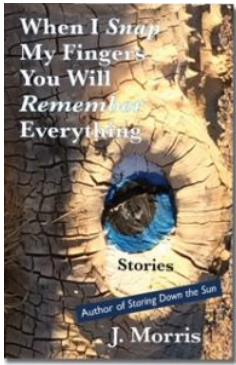

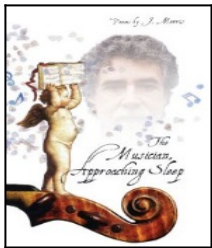
