Communion Liturgy

This communion liturgy is used between the offering and reflections/announcements in the season's regular liturgy.

PREPARATION

Leader 1: We gather now as one body, joined around the table.

Leader 2: Here we celebrate God's presence among us united in Christ's spirit, broken and whole all at once;

All: Nourished and hungry, loved and loving, sinner and forgiven; we make one circle of knowing, believing, rejoicing, being, as God lights and rests among us.

COMMUNION HYMN

INVITATION

Leader 1: This is the table of the Heavenly Feast, the joyful celebration of the people of God.

Leader 2: Christ invites everyone to eat the bread of life, to drink the cup of the new covenant.

Voice 1: Jesus said, "I am the bread of life. She who comes to me shall never hunger; he who believes in me shall never thirst."

Voice 2: In the beginning, God provided every plant yielding seed and every tree with seed in its fruit for food.

Voice 1: When the Israelites were in the wilderness, God fed them with miraculous food.

Voice 2: When the crowds were hungry, Jesus fed over five thousand with two fish and five loaves of bread.

All: When two were walking towards Emmaeus, they recognized the Anointed One as they broke bread together.

THE MEAL

Leader 1: On the night of his arrest Jesus took bread, and after giving thanks to God, broke it and said, "This is my body which is for you; do this remembering me."

Leader 2: After supper Jesus took the cup and said, "This is the cup of the new covenant; whenever you drink it, do so remembering me."
