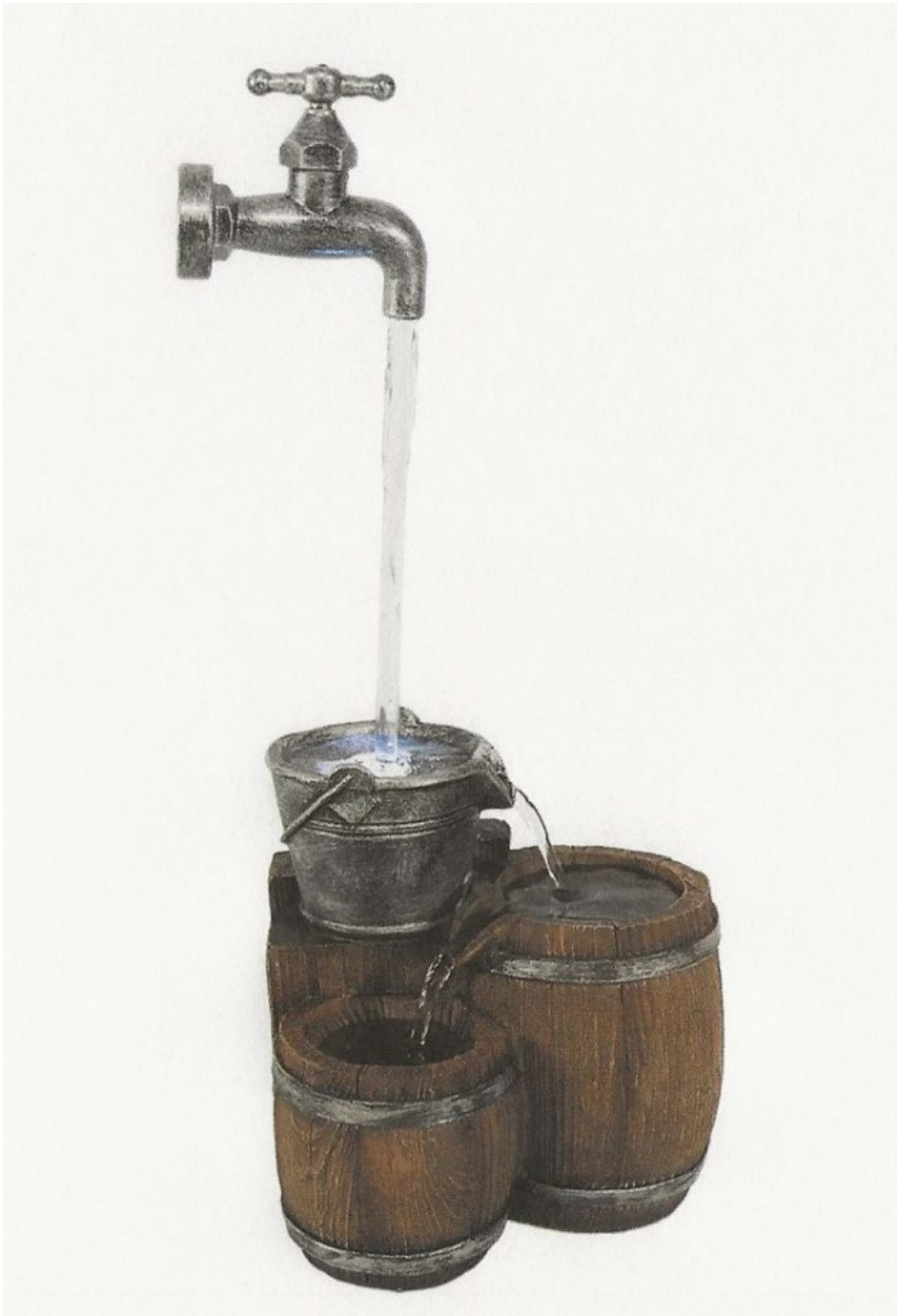
Unless otherwise indicated, we use the [Revised Common Lectionary](#), a list of Bible readings used by many churches and denominations around the world.
