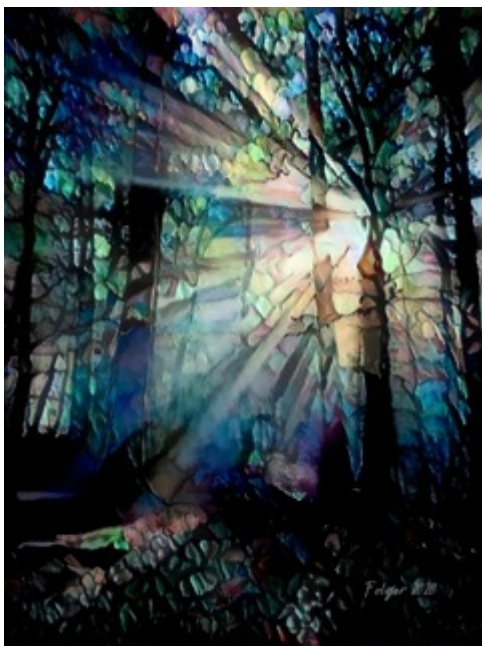


Lectioary
